

Minnesota Policy Adjustment

The *Minnesota Policy Adjustment* includes policy-related costs such as conservation programs and system or resource investments. Items included in this adjustment are:

- Solar Energy Adjustment charge includes the cost and benefits of solar energy purchased
 to meet the state's Solar Energy Standard. Because solar energy production will differ
 from month to month, this line item will vary.
- Conservation Program Adjustment (CPA) a portion of costs related to our programs and services that promote Minnesota's energy conservation and optimization policy. The CPA factor is recalculated annually.

• Renewable Resources includes costs for additional renewable energy and the transmission required to deliver this energy to our system. We are investing in renewable energy projects as economically as possible to meet Minnesota's Renewable Energy Standard of 25% renewable energy by the year 2025.

• *Transmission Cost Recovery* includes costs for new transmission facilities that are necessary for reliable delivery of electricity to customers.

Affordability Surcharge

The Affordability Surcharge recovers the costs of a rate affordability discount program for incomequalified residential electricity customers. The rate is charged monthly for each service agreement (SA) by rate class.

Affordability Surcharge Rate:

Residential (\$/month per SA) (except LIHEAP-qualified)	\$2.41
General Service (\$/month per SA)	\$4.01
Large Light & Power (\$/month per SA)	\$26.74
Large Power (\$/month per SA)	\$1,826.31
