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
Population Health

The Scope of the Problem

- 9 million households considered "unhealthy"
- O 3% of US health care costs due to inefficient and unhealthy housing
- O 14 million missed days of school asthma is #1 reason
- \$30 billion anticipated cost by 2020 due to trip and fall injuries to seniors
- O \$43.4 billion currently due to lead poisoning
- O 535,000 lead poisoned children
 - O Increased Juvenile Crime 600%
 - O Increased Drop Out Rate 700%
 - O Decrease in Lifetime Earnings




Just Lead...

- \$4 million households with children exposed to high levels of lead
- \$43.4 billion currently due to lead poisoning
- O 535,000 lead poisoned children
 - O Increased Juvenile Crime 600%
 - O Increased Drop Out Rate 700%
 - O Decrease in Lifetime Earnings
- O Learning disabilities/loss of IQ points
- O ADD/Hyperactivity
- O Speech Language Delays




Green and Healthy Homes Initiative

- O For every \$1 of lead hazard control programs, ROI \$17-\$221
- O Adjusted for inflation, \$954,000 per child for 2.2 to 4.7 IQ point increase





 - O Safe




DRY

- O Dihydrogen monoxide kills!
- Water can cause mold, structural damage, and provides optimal conditions to attract pests

- O Repair leaks
- Ensure proper waterproofing
- O Proper ventilation
- Educate residents on operations and maintenance

Consider Rain Ready Housing Principles

- O Coordinate to combat and prepare for more frequent storms
- Many improvements aid in energy efficiency




Water leaks = mold hazards



Interwoven Interventions

- O Lead Hazards
 - O Window replacement
 - O Paint stabilization
 - O Lead safe work practices and lead-specific cleaning
- O Integrated Pest Management
 - O Baits, traps, reduced entry, behaviorial change
 - Mattress and pillow covers
- Ventilation Improvements
 - O Air conditioners, dehumidifiers, and kitchen, bath, and dryer venting
- Mold remediation
- Removal or cleaning of carpets
- Household injury prevention
 - O CO and smoke detectors, cabinet locks and electrical outlet covers, trip and fall hazard repair
- O HEPA-vacuum and indoor allergen reduction kit
- O Radon/asbestos
- Weatherization/EE
 - O Caulking, air duct sealing, plumbing repairs, hot water heater blanket, programmable thermostats, etc.
